

# GANDA MANDINGO SYNDICATE

Habib Koité was born in Thiès, Senegal, and is a Malian singer and musician.

He grew up among the griots, then entered the National Institute of Arts in Bamako thanks to the support of his uncle. After becoming a teacher there, he started his career and quickly became known as a prodigy in his field. He is indeed known primarily for his unique approach to playing the guitar by tuning it on a pentatonic scale and playing on open strings as one would on a kamale n'goni. His music is also influenced by traditional Malian sounds, but also blues or flamenco

His work and his band Bamada are recognized worldwide, he has received numerous awards and collaborated with the world's greatest musicians.



These three magnificent artists are joining forces for a unique concert!

With more than 20 years of experience and touring all over the world, these artists will offer you a show as energetic as innovative. After spending a week in residence together, they will create a concert where their West African and East African music merge to create new sounds.

Between Flamenco, Blues, Mandingo, Jazz and traditional music, this concert is without a doubt one of the most outstanding of the year. We are delighted to welcome these internationally renowned artists to the sublime auditorium of the National Theater. A buffet dinner provided by the Sheraton will be offered for VIP seats.



Joel Sebunjo is a Ugandan musician and one of the most visible figures to emerge from the Anglophone. Joel Sebunjo is one of a handful of Ugandan folk/world music artists. The multi-nistrumentalist's latest album United Slaves of Africa is rooted in Pan-Africanism and negritude aspirations, and is spiced up with bits of Ugandan folklore rhythms.

Alongside his Sundiata band, Sebunjo has performed around the world and shared a stage with international artistes like Salif Keita, Miriam Makeba, Yossou N'dour and Oliver Mukudzi.

Aly Keïta is certainly the greatest Balafon player in the world. A specialist of this xylophone-like instrument from West Africa, he has even created his own Balafon to match his style and sound.

Born in Abidjan, he focuses on traditional African repertoire, with western jazz, soft pop and African rhythms.

Starting his career in the 80's he began playing jazz with musician Georges Makinto but quickly opened up to other styles. His experience gave him the opportunity to perform and to be known with success all over the world.



Michiel van Oosterhout is a journalist/filmmaker/researcher from The Netherlands. 'Bwana Jogoo: the ballad of Jessy Gitta' is his 2019 feature music documentary director's debut, which won an award at the Uganda Film Festival that year.



Pearl Rhythm festival under the directorship of Jude Mugerwa will in this edition of Akatuuti, develop a body of work which will use different forms of art to address climate change challenges happening in the world currently as seen through the eyes of children.

The body of art we envision will fuse art forms like folk and ethno music, traditional sounds, dance and visual art together with digital art in order to bring out different textures of expression both to the viewer and listener. The body of work will employ natural sounds in our environment that will be fused with

modern synths, to tell a story as seen by

a child. The most exciting bit of the showcase will be fusion of body art and young human models to blend into the whole experience to tell a story of nature and climate change hazards such as wildfires, flooding, drought and vanishing green cover due to deforestation and urbanization.
