The Francophonie is an institution, dedicated to promoting the French language and political, educational, economic and cultural cooperation among the 88 member countries of the Organisation internationale de la Francophonie. It is celebrated in commemoration of the 1970 Niamey Convention, where French-speaking states signed to align their mutual interest. On this day, the 220 million francophones, across five different continents, celebrate their language and celebrate the diversity and love for the French language. The Francophonie day celebrations take form in the presentation of plays, poetry reading, and art exhibitions, among other activities. The beauty of language is that as we learn it, we too are part of its evolution because language can change and adapt. The learning of language is neatly intertwined with its evolution.

The Francophonie's mission mandates are:

- To promote the French language and cultural and linguistic diversity;**
- To promote peace, democracy and human rights;**
- To support education, training, higher education and research;**
- To foster economic cooperation to bolster sustainable development.**

NJOGERA FRANÇAIS



What is Njogera Français?

Njogera Français - I Speak French - Je Parle Français is a DELF schools competition that aims to motivate and inspire French teachers and French learning students/pupils, and strengthen Francophone ties with Ugandan Public and Private Schools/ Universities.

The competition is open to all undergraduate university students, high school students, primary pupils currently enrolled in a public, private and international schools or other recognized secondary education institution, including francophone students learning in Ugandan schools.

The competition rewards the students and schools with the DELF certificate, an official certificate awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the competency of candidates from outside France in the French language. This certificate doesn't expire, it's for life.

The competition runs throughout the year with two sessions for the DELF Prim in May and November 2023. Two sessions for the DELF junior in June and November 2023 and four sessions for the DELF tout public (adult) in March, June, September and December 2023.

Schools register their students according to their age and level. At the end of the different sessions, different prizes are awarded to the best students, to the schools with the best results and to the schools with the highest number of registrations. Two teachers are also rewarded with a trip to France.
